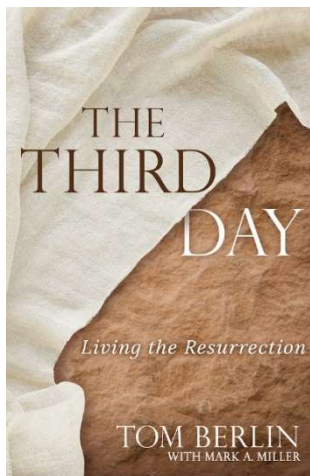

York County Food Closet Update – Let's continue to remember our neighbors in need. The Food Closet's current need is for canned soups. Thank you for your support of this vital ministry.



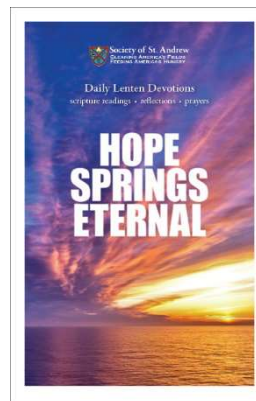
