#### OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Psalm 26

<sup>1</sup> Vindicate me, O LORD, for I have walked in my integrity, and I have trusted in the LORD without wavering. <sup>2</sup> Prove me, O LORD, and try me; test my heart and mind. <sup>3</sup> For your steadfast love is before my eyes, and I walk in faithfulness to you. <sup>4</sup> I do not sit with the worthless, nor do I consort with hypocrites; <sup>5</sup> I hate the company of evildoers and will not sit with the wicked. <sup>6</sup> I wash my hands in innocence and go around your altar, O LORD, <sup>7</sup> singing aloud a song of thanksgiving and telling all your wondrous deeds. <sup>8</sup> O LORD, I love the house in which you dwell and the place where your glory abides. <sup>9</sup> Do not sweep me away with sinners nor my life with the bloodthirsty, <sup>10</sup> those in whose hands are evil devices and whose right hands are full of bribes. <sup>11</sup> But as for me, I walk in my integrity; redeem me and be gracious to me. <sup>12</sup> My foot stands on level ground; in the great congregation I will bless the LORD.

CHILDREN'S TIME

GOSPEL LESSON Mark 10:2-16

<sup>2</sup> Some, testing him, asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife?" <sup>3</sup> He answered them, "What did Moses command you?" 4 They said, "Moses allowed a man to write a certificate of dismissal and to divorce her." <sup>5</sup> But Jesus said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart he wrote this commandment for you. <sup>6</sup> But from the beginning of creation, 'God made them male and female.' 7 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, 8 and the two shall become one flesh.' So they are no longer two but one flesh. 9 Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate." <sup>10</sup> Then in the house the disciples asked him again about this matter. <sup>11</sup> He said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her, <sup>12</sup> and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery." <sup>13</sup> People were bringing children to him in order that he might touch them, and the disciples spoke sternly to them. <sup>14</sup> But when Jesus saw this, he was indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not stop them, for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs. 15 Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it." 16 And he took them up in his arms, laid his hands on them, and blessed them.


