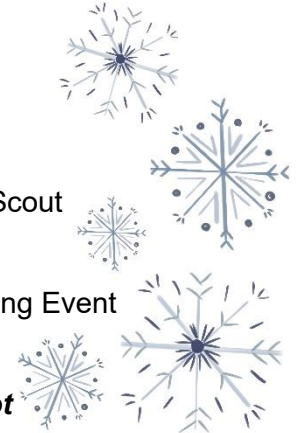

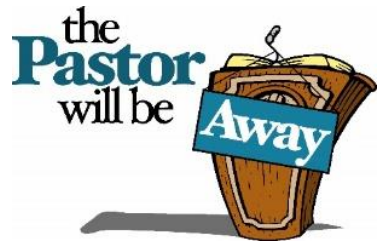

- **Youth Teacher while Jordan is on Maternity Leave starting in April.**



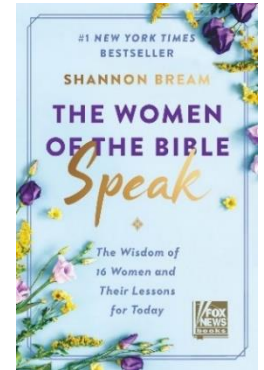
