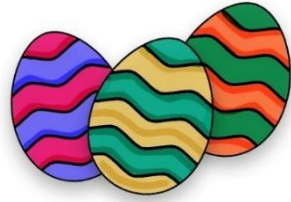


Expecting Mother's Reception TODAY - Following Worship

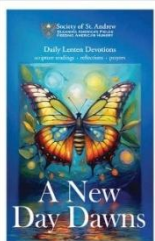
