OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Psalm 30:4-12

⁴ Sing praises to the LORD, O you his faithful ones, and give thanks to his holy name. ⁵ For his anger is but for a moment; his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may linger for the night, but joy comes with the morning. ⁶ As for me, I said in my prosperity, “I shall never be moved.” ⁷ By your favor, O LORD, you had established me as a strong mountain; you hid your face; I was dismayed. ⁸ To you, O LORD, I cried, and to the LORD I made supplication: ⁹ “What profit is there in my death, if I go down to the Pit?
