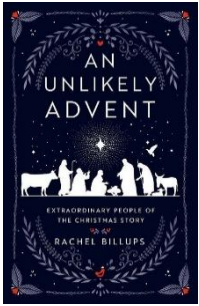

October 30 – 9 am to Noon Set up

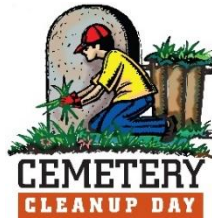
October 31 – 9 am Peel & Chop Potatoes and continue Set Up.
